

A regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the Tennessee Chess Association was held at Martin Junior High School, Crossville, Tennessee on Sunday September 4, 1988, at 8:00 p.m.

Directors present were Bill Orgain, Harry Sabine, Mark Schindler, Rick Igou, Mark Ishee, Lee Edwards, Morris Lewis, Paul Linxwiler, and Chester Crowley. Director absent was Curt Jones.

President Orgain presided. The minutes of the Board of Directors meeting of March 6, 1988 were approved as read.

Officers' reports were given by Bill Orgain, Harry Sabine, Mark Schindler, Lee Edwards, Rick Igou, and Mark Ishee.

It was agreed that the next Board of Directors meeting would be held at the Fairfield Glade Resort in Crossville, Tennessee on Saturday, December 31, 1988 at 10:00 a.m.

It was agreed that all bids for the 1989 Tennessee Open would be due by December 31, 1988.

Upon motion duly made, seconded, and carried, the Budget for 1988-89 was approved and a copy ordered appended to the minutes of this meeting.

It was agreed that all bids for the 1989 Tennessee Amateur Team Tournament would be due by December 31, 1988.

Upon motion duly made, seconded, and carried, the 1988-89 Tennessee Turkey Tour was approved with the same format as the previous year.

Chester Crowley gave a report on the 1989 National High School Tournament and indicated that everyone would be needed to help.

Bill Organ appointed a committee of himself, Mark Ishee, and Rick Igou to consider a Tennessee Chess Hall of Fame and report back at the next Board meeting.

A motion was made, seconded, and carried to allocate 20% of each patron membership received to the Scholastic Trust Fund and 20% to the Endowment Fund.

The subject of Postal Chess Appeals was discussed. It was agreed that in the event of an appeal, the Postal Coordinator would appoint a committee of three persons to hear the appeal. If further appeal was desired, the appeal would come before the full Board of Directors.

The Tennessee School Boards Association Convention to be held on November 13-14, 1988, at the Nashville Convention Center was discussed. It was agreed that Bill Orgain, Mark Ishee, Morris Lewis, Harry Sabine, and anyone else who wanted to participate, would meet in the near future to discuss plans for the Association's booth at the convention.

The subject of a Tennessee - Kentucky match was deferred until the December meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

This year's Tennessee Open section winner and new State Champion is Charles Schulien, a Senior Master who has recently moved to Cleveland, Tennessee. Chales scored  $5\frac{1}{2}$  out of a possible 6 points in the event and defeated several Masters along the way, including the defending champion, Senior Master Ronald Burnett of Antioch, in the last round game for the title. Congratulations to Charles for his fine win!


In the Amateur section, Lee Edwards of Nashville finished with  $5^{\perp_2}$  out of a possible 6 points to win the State Amateur Championship title. Lee is well-known for his skill and devotion at postal chess, and now he has begun to add O-T-B victories to his list of credits as well. Nice work, Lee – we'll see you in the Open section next year!

In other noteworthy news, Nashville high school student R.O. Mitchell won the title of State Junior Champion. This title goes to the highest scoring player in the Open section who is under the age of twenty (20) years. Mitchell, a seventeen year old junior attending Hume-Fogg High School, is a former State High School Champion and is one of the highest rated players his age in the United States. His 3-3 score in a VERY strong field was also good enough to earn a tie for the Class A prize, so R.O. was a "double winner" on Labor Day. Watch this young man in the future - - - he has tremendous potential, especially considering that he is a relative newcomer to tournament chess.

Algebraic notation is now standard for TCA postal events, although players may agree to use descriptive notation, the Uedemann Code, or some other system. There are new rules regarding the use of "if" moves and a "postal touch move" rule. Finally, all players are required to submit a complete scoresheet when they report their results.

One way to improve your chess rating is to improve your chess knowledge. Is there a better place to start learning than at the beginning? The "Opening" can be the place you either get a small advantage to carry throughout the game and go on to a smashing victory, or it can be the place where you move your pawns while your pieces stay at home until your opponent (through sheer luck, of course) gets his pieces into play just in time to defeat you.

Does the first way sound like the best for you? If it does, then you should be familiar with the term *DEVELOPMENT*; and *DEVELOPMENT* is the first basic principle of chess. Just what is development? Simply stated, it is moving your pieces from their starting squares to another square where they will be able to attack one of your opponents pieces or exert pressure on certain key squares. I say certain squares because sometimes it is more important to attack a square to keep your opponent from moving to it than it is to directly attack his pieces.

One of the main concerns in the opening is to develop your pieces to the proper square the *FIRST* time and not move your pieces again until you have all your other pieces developed on their best squares. Developing your pieces to their best squares also includes getting your King to safety by castling. Castling serves two purposes: 1) It gets your King to safety behind a wall of pawns and 2) It connects the Rooks for your attack. The earlier that you can castle, the faster you can begin an earnest attack.

You should remember that you *NEVER* begin your attack until all of your pieces are developed. The reason for this is that the one or two pieces that you attack with will have to fight your opponent's entire army and they would be vastly outnumbered and soon lost. Then you would just have to develop some of your other pieces anyway. Why not just go ahead and get them all into the game early and get it over with?

Just remember to develop your pieces to their best square the first time so that you don't lose tempo (waste time) and give your opponent "free moves" to get his pieces developed first and then have him start an attack against you.

# RULES AND REGULATIONS
