4 Round Swiss System – In a Swiss system tournament, everyone plays all rounds. Tournament is open to all Students in Grades K-5 through 12th.

4 Sections – High School: 12th and below, Middle School: 9th and below, Elementary Section: 6th and below, Primary: 3rd and below – Sections may be combined or divided if turnout warrants it.

Individual Trophies awarded to Top Five Players in each Section, plus two trophies to best players in 11th, 10th, 8th, 7th, 5th, 4th, 2nd, 1st, K-5. Trophies awarded to Top 5 players in Simul after tournament.

Team Trophies awarded to the school with the most players finishing in the top 7 of each section. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place trophies will be given to the top schools in each section. Come enjoy some team competition as you also compete individually! There is no limit to the number of players on the school team.

Registration: Registration and check-in will be held from 11:00-11:30. All players must check-in by 11:30. **Entry Fee is \$15.00 before 5 pm on Friday, October 27th, 2017 and \$20 after this date.** Please pre-register by sending an email with name, grade, school, and section to chesstd2200@gmail.com to allow time for entry into our pairing program.
