| Format | 5 Rounds Swiss Pairing System. Time Control: Game in 30 minutes each with a 5-second delay. |

The top 2 local players from High School, Junior High, Elementary and Primary qualify to play in the 2020 Nashville City Championship!! To qualify, players must live within a 50-mile radius of The Nashville Chess Center. The 2020 Nashville City Championship will take place January 3-5, 2020 at the NCC. |
