Mike Barton Memorial Tournament

The 7th Mike Barton Memorial Chess Tournament was held in Memphis at the IBEW Local 474 on September 16-17, 2017. It was a good turnout despite football, fall festivals, foot races, and fairs going on all around. There were 35

History of the Mike Barton Memorial:

This tournament came about by Mike having been a respected member of the club since the 1980's, and having served as club president in 1993. He passed away in 2002. On January 2, 2011, I wrote Carl Barton and Gary Pylant about an October 2010 visit to the MCC by Gary Newsom. Here is a portion of the correspondence. "Gary Newsom stopped by the club awhile back. He lives in North Carolina now and never stopped playing chess. (He helped found the current Queen City Chess Club which is now known as the [Charlotte Chess Center & Scholastic Academy](#)) Mr. Newsom and Mike were friends from way back. Gary Newsom was bothered that we did not have a "Mike Barton" memorial tournament after Mike's passing. He said the club had given memorial tournaments in many people's names, but not Mike. Mike did give a year of service when he was elected president of the club in 1993. I (Dwight Weaver) quit playing chess back in 2000 and just this past year (2010) started back. I promised Mr. Newsom to check out why a memorial had not been organized, and to see what I could do about it. April 24, 2011: To Memphis Club President Edgar Davidson: This week the owners of [Chess Central](#), a chess equipment company, has offered us sponsorship for a "Mike Barton Memorial" tournament. They are specific in having this tournament dedicated to honor Mike. The owners, Sid and Janet Pickard, were long-time Memphis residents and were good friends of Mike. Sid was also Memphis City Champion at one time. May 1, 2011: From Carl Barton, Mike's brother: "I mentioned Sid and Janet's generosity to my Dad and we have agreed to match the contribution on a yearly basis for the tournament." Over the years, Carl Barton donated quite a bit to the tournament, and they increased their donations over the past three years. He made a statement after I gave him the results of this year's event. He said to me, "Thank you for taking the lead on the 7 tournaments honoring Mike's memory and love for chess. The creation of the tournament made my Dad very happy and I also thank you for

that. Given the current participation of Mike's chess buddies, I think it is a good time to stop. It has been a good run and Mike liked to quote the Gambler 'You've got to know when to hold 'em. Know when to fold 'em'."

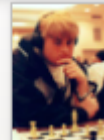
