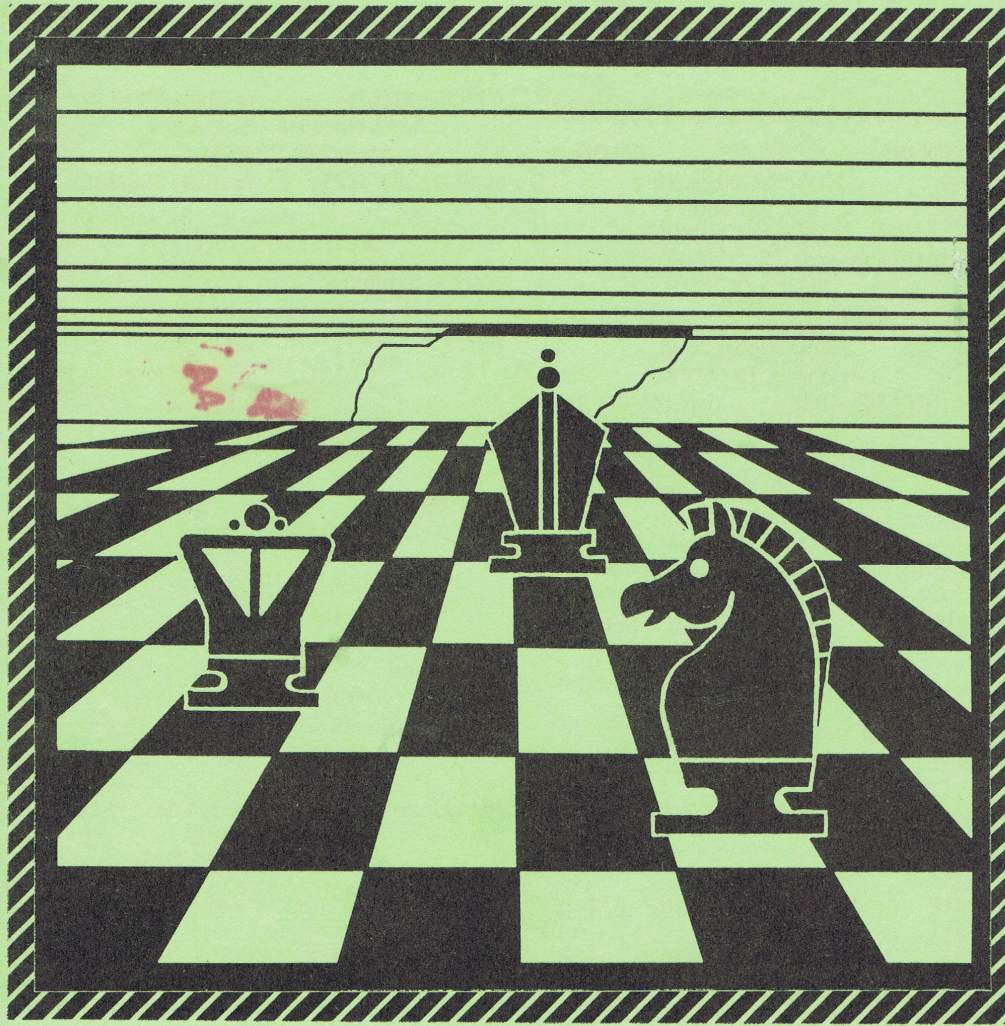

EDITORIAL

If you haven't paid much attention to things going on in the United States chess scene over the past year or two, it might come as a surprise to you that with every passing month, there are more and more "Action Chess" events being held all over this country. It isn't at all unusual to see five or more rounds being played in a day's time with the time control being Game/30. In this issue, our Correspondence Game "guru", Lee Edwards will give his thoughts on this phenomenon in his column. It should be noted that we have an event coming up in July in Dickson County that will utilize this same format. Simply as an observation, I expect to see chess become a spectator sport on T.V., complete with commercial interruption, in the near future in some media markets. It is a pity that Americans are in such of a hurry about most everything, including chess. I know all the arguments about the advantages of this format, *i.e.* more rounds in less time thus eliminating the need for overnight accommodations, etc., but speaking for myself, I would rather return to the era of "the big think".

I took an opportunity to get out and play in the Music City Spring Open tournament the other day. Those folks down in Nashville did another fine job in organizing and running their tournament and should be commended. It also reminds me that we have some *fine* Tournament Directors here in this state. In what is often times a "thankless" position, I wanted to take this opportunity to show appreciation on behalf of all of us - - - without them, over-the-board tournaments would be impossible. If you haven't played OTB recently, get out and travel - - it'll be worth the trip!

The Tennessee Open tournament will be moving east this fall, with the bid from the Cumberland County Chess Club being the one accepted. If there is just ONE tournament that Tennessee chessplayers should attend during the year, the Tennessee Open is the one. This year marks the 42nd consecutive year for the Open which, of course, makes it a Heritage Event. Make plans NOW to be in Crossville over the Labor Day weekend!

Finally, I would like to hear from some of you chessplayers out there. If you've played some especially noteworthy games, please send them on to me or one of my assistant editors (algebraic notation only please). I will gladly include them in our published games section. Letters to the editor are always welcome and if we get a steady flow of them, I will start a column dedicated to them. Remember - - - the TCN is *your* publication!

THE PRESIDENT'S COLUMN

Greetings, fellow chess players. This issue's column is dedicated to those tireless souls that spend their free time teaching school-children chess and taking them all over in their search for tournament excellence. I will try to provide some insights I have discovered personally, both as a coach and as a scholastic tournament director.

First and foremost, we must remember to teach our students that chess is just a game. Sportsmanship is sadly lacking in many of the scholastic events I direct. Winning is pushed so hard at many kids that the chess itself becomes secondary. The children become so preoccupied with technicalities and trying to "trip-up" their opponent away from the board, that they cannot exert a reasonable effort at finding mate in three. Winning is not important, teaching children the "will to win" is.

Secondly, teach your children the rules of the game. The rules are not to be taught as a substitute for the play of the game, but rather should be learned for their own protection. In other words, the rules should be used defensively, not offensively. Rules as such were designed to protect players' rights.

Along this same vein, all players should be taught how to take notation of one form or another, **REGARDLESS OF THEIR AGE**. Taking notation is **REQUIRED** by the rules of the game. Many times I have had to start a game from scratch because I was summoned to a board in a primary or elementary section where a dispute in the position had occurred. Neither player would have a score, nor could they even agree, let alone remember, where the last piece moved had originated. If the requirement of the rules is insufficient motivation, how are you going to help your players learn from their mistakes if they can't replay their games? How are they to ever claim time forfeits or fifty move draws or three-fold repetitions?

Third, make your kids use chess clocks when available. They will have to do so in tournament play and it will be detrimental to them to have to use half their conscious thought in remembering to push the button. Speed chess as part of their chess curriculum will take care of this. It will also sharpen their tactical eye and teach them how to deal with time trouble.

Fourth, be careful what you teach. An old saying goes, "a little knowledge is a dangerous thing". When working with beginners, start with mate and work your way through games backwards. Many is the time I have been asked by a Scholastic Player, "is this mate?". I still find this incredible even though I have been asked it a hundred times. Don't they know? What are they doing in a tournament if they don't understand the fundamental object of the game - check-mate? Teach them the three step test: Capture, Interpose, Run. If they can't do this, then it's mate. If they can't deal with this, how are they going to handle the **REAL** intricacies of the game? After teaching mate, go to endgames, then middle games, then lastly, openings. All throughout, do not teach "lines"! **TEACH CONCEPTS**. No one can learn all the "lines" of chess, and even if one could, what would the player do when his opponent leaves "book"? The axioms of the game are almost universal. The master is the one that knows the axioms front and back, but also knows when to deviate from them. In essence, don't teach beginners as if they were already masters. Dedication to the principles of the game will prepare your young players for the rude surprises that await them on the board.

As a last note to the coaches, when you take kids to tournament, you are a teacher and a supervisor. Don't let your kids run wild and make them adhere to the rules of etiquette around the tournament hall. This will make these events much more pleasant for all.

I hope you have found this informative. I invite your comments and suggestions through the "Letters to the Editor".

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE TENNESSEE CHESS ASSN.

March 6, 1988

A regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the Tennessee Chess Association was held at Memphis University School, 6191 Park Avenue, Memphis, Tennessee on Sunday March 6, 1988, at 9:30 a.m.

Directors present were Bill Orgain, Harry Sabine, Mark Schindler, Rick Igou, Curt Jones, and Chester Crowley. Directors absent were Peter Lahde, Lee Edwards, Dale Flickinger, and Ron Burnett.

President Orgain presided. The minutes of the Board of Directors meeting of September 6, 1987 were approved as read.

Officers' reports were given by Bill Orgain, Harry Sabine, Mark Schindler, Rick Igou, and Curt Jones.

Mark Schindler made a motion that the Board consider putting in place a system of producing mailing labels for use by organizers in tournaments in Tennessee which would be sanctioned by the TCA. Harry Sabine proposed a substitute motion that the President appoint a committee to study the matter and report back to the Board at the Labor Day meeting. The substitute motion was approved and the President appointed a committee of Mark Schindler and Rick Igou to review the matter.

Bids for the 1988 Tennessee Open were submitted by Bill Orgain and the Cumberland County Chess Club. After full discussion, the bid of the Cumberland County Chess Club was approved with members Orgain and Sabine abstaining. A copy of both bids will appear in the Tennessee Chess News along with these minutes.

Harry Sabine proposed that the 1989 Tennessee Scholastics be changed to two separate tournaments; an individual event and a team event, with the team event to consist of regional qualifiers held in four separate regions on a Saturday, with four teams from each section in each region qualifying to play in the State Finals to be held in Middle Tennessee two weeks after the regionals. The proposal was unanimously adopted, and the President appointed a committee of Bill Orgain, Curt Jones, Harry Sabine and Rick Igou, with the power to approve all details.

Chester Crowley announced that he had submitted a bid for the 1989 National High School Tournament to be held in Knoxville, Tennessee on May 5-7, 1989. A motion was made and approved that the TCA become a joint sponsor of the bid, sharing equally with Crowley on all profit or loss from the tournament with the TCA agreeing to advance the \$500.00 guarantee against loss for the tournament.

The resignation of Ronald Burnett as the Middle Tennessee Director was accepted by the Board with regret. Mr. F. Morris Lewis was elected by the Board to fill Burnett's unexpired term.

The disbursement of Patron Membership funds and all Endowment and Scholastic funds was discussed and the matter was deferred until the Labor Day meeting of the Board.

The subject of a Tennessee Chess Hall of Fame was discussed. The President indicated he would be appointing a committee to study the subject further and report back to the Board.

Harry Sabine moved that the TCA request \$275.00 of the SASP funds to use for the purpose of obtaining a booth at the Annual Tennessee School Boards Association Convention to be held at the Nashville Convention Center on November 13-14, 1988. The motion was duly seconded and approved.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 11:25 a.m.

A total of 175 players turned out to play for \$5000.00 in prize money in the Eleventh Annual Fairfield Glade Open. The competition was unyielding in all three sections as there was not a perfect score to be found after the last round was finished.

In the Open Section, four players managed near-perfect scores of $4\frac{1}{2} - \frac{1}{2}$ to claim a share of the top prize. Ron Burnett, Tom Friedel, Benjamin Finegold, and Edward Formanek each earned \$275.00 for their outstanding efforts.

In the Amateur Section, Nathan D. McNeal was the only competitor to be found on top, once the dust had settled, to take the top prize of \$350.00. Fine efforts were posted by both Jerry Spinrad and Keith Adkins who finished tied for second place, just $\frac{1}{2}$ point behind McNeal.

Jerrel A. Graham was the champion of the Novice Section, posting a commendable $4\frac{1}{2} - \frac{1}{2}$ performance, and walked away with \$350.00 and the trophy. Adam White and Jim Kade tied for second.

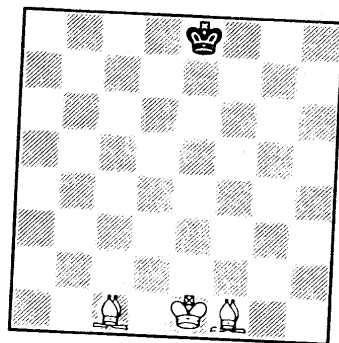

LEARNING TO USE THE PIECES (part II)

This is the second of a series on how to use the pieces. Part I dealt with mating with the Knight and Bishop. This part will be dealing with mating using the two Bishops.

As you will see, the mating procedure becomes much easier using the two Bishops rather than that required using a Knight and Bishop.

Let's start with this position:



1. Bg2 Ke7 2. Bb2 Ke6 (the Black King will have to be mated in one of the corners. His best chance will be to get to the center of the board and hope that you make a mistake) **3. Ke2 Kf5 4. Bd5!** (this is to force the King to the side of the board) **4... Kf4 5. Bd5 Kf5 6. Ke3 Kg4 7. Be4 Kg5 8. Be5 Kg4** (it is no accident that the Bishops are placed side by side. From here they can protect each other and also keep the Black King on one side of the board. Notice also that they are placed on the fourth rank [or file] from the side of the board. This is so that you can get your King in front of them.) **9. Kf2 Kh3 10. Kf3 Kh4 11. Kf4 Kh3 12. Bg7 Kh4 13. Bg6 Kh3 14. Kf3 Kh4 15. Bf6+ Kh3 16. Bf5+ Kh2 17. Be5+ Kg1 18. Bh3 Kh1 19. Kg3 Kg1 20.
