

## **Recruit That Casual Fan**

Last year I was surprized to learn that my home state (Oklahoma) had 386 members of the United States Chess Federation, but only 110 members of the Oklahoma Chess Association. Shocked by this discovery, I set out to correct this imbalance.

In two weeks I signed up fifteen new members in the OCA, a rate slightly better than one person per day. Had I maintained this pace, the number of OCA members would have more than tripled, swelling the coffers of the state association, making me a cinch to be elected treasurer, at which point I could have absconded with the funds and be writing this today from some cozy, beach-front hotel in Costa Rica, far removed from the long reach of extradition.

But, alas, after two weeks, more pressing demands compelled my attention and some time passed before I could return to my objective.

However, for those two weeks I was an ambassador for organized, recorded, rated, and reported local chess. I learned a few things about promoting local chess during that time, and I'd like to pass them on to you.

For one thing, I discovered that people had been joining our state association only when they had to. That is to say, OCA membership is required for nearly all USCF tournaments in Oklahoma, and people join the OCA because they have to play in a tournament.

In turn, the OCA provides this sharply focused group of deadly serious tournament chess players with a quarterly bulletin (about twenty pages) reporting the results of recently completed tournaments, including crosstables and many games from the events, both annotated and unannotated, using either algebraic or descriptive notation, along with many fine articles by association members reporting and analyzing some of their most outstanding recent tournament games, both in-state and out-of-state.

And all of this, both the playing of the games and the reporting of the games, was taking place outside the kin of the casual chess-playing public. You had to be a member of the OCA to play in a tournament; only members of the OCA received a copy of the state association quarterly bulletin

Therefore, none of the people I approached about joining the OCA had ever seen a copy of the Oklahoma Chess Bulletin. All of them were fascinated by it. All of them who joined the OCA did so to get a subscription to the bulletin.

As this phenomenon repeated itself over and over, I gradually came to realize a few things about casual chess players. First, and most importantly, I learned that casual players are facinated by USCF Masters. We were fortunate, being so far removed from the centers of population, to have three very active Masters in Oklahoma, Masters who not only competed often, but who shared their thoughts frequently with annotated games in the bulletin.

For the casual player, the opportunity to see how a Master plays a game of chess, and to study these games at their leisure, prompted most of them to join the OCA on the spot. Furthermore, for some of them, the prospect of entering into tournament play, and, through the caprices of fortune and Swiss System pairings to actually have a chance to play a game against a Master - not ten years from now in Timbuktu - but next month right here in town, was too much to resist.

Now, when I say casual players, I do mean *casual* players. None of them knew chess notation. None of them ever heard of a chess clock (this is the dead giveaway. When you ask someone if they use a chess clock and they say, "Chess clock? What's that?", you can bet the farm that they'll not be able to demonstrate the first two moves of the Queen's Gambit). Yet, they love to play chess and have been playing chess for years.

Now, I don't mean to disparage casual chess players. They love chess and I love chess and I love them for their love of chess. But to get them to join your state association, you have to do a bit of teaching along with the selling.

So I taught them chess notation. And I showed them what a chess clock looks like, either a real one, if I happened to have one with me, or a picture of one from one of the ads in *Chess Life*. And I told them about the center of the board, demonstrating how the powers of the Queen, the Bishop, and the Knight are all enhanced if they can be placed in any one of the four center squares, explaining how all of the standard openings are therefore predicated, in one way or another, on securing a share of that critical terrain. This may sound like very basic stuff, but it was, without exception, news to them.

If you're beginning to get the picture that these people did not exactly fit your standard profile of a USCF affiliated state association member, then you are on the right track. Yet, all of them became card-carrying, dues-paying members of same.

Where did I find them? Coffee shops mostly. Only three or four were even casual acquaintances. Most were total strangers. I'd carry a small chess set with me (the kind that folds in half forming a box to hold the pieces inside, with the chessboard easily recognizable on the outside), set it on the counter beside my coffee, along with my chess magazines, and wait for some action. It usually didn't take long.

As soon as someone struck up a conversation about chess, I'd ask them if they were a member of the Oklahoma Chess Association, then show them a copy of the *OCA Bulletin*. Most of them ended up shelling out the six dollars for the membership dues within about a half hour. I must have an honest face because all of them entrusted their cash to me. I also volunteered to pay the 90¢ fee for a postal money order and take care of mailing in their application, which I might not have needed to do. *But, I wanted members, not promises*.

In my state, and I assume in yours, the financial well-being of our state association and its bulletin, is directly related to the number of members. In order to publish a bigger, better bulletin, we have to have new members. If you decide to try this method of drumming up some new members for your state association, here are a few tips that might help:

- 1) Carry around a copy of your state association magazine. Make it a part of your gear.
- 2) Since you have it with you, take a look at it now and then. Learn its contents. Be able to move with ease and facility from feature to feature. Bear in mind that it's a subscription to this publication that's going to entice the casual player to join your association.
- 3) Don't be afraid to teach what you know. Chess notation, the operation of a chess clock, how Steinitz changed chess and why the Romanticists hated him bitterly for it... even the most rudimentary principles, clearly presented, might provide the spark that rekindles someone's interest.
- 4) Don't allow yourself to become bored with basic principles. A distinguished historian once urged his colleagues to "remember that you are doing your best teaching when you are explaining for the 1,000th time how to pursue a topic through the library." The same might be said for demonstrating why it is rarely advisable to bring one's Queen into play early.
- 5) The people you recruit need not have any inclination to become tournament players. It's all right for them to be fans. It's all right for chess in your area to have fans (dues-paying, non-participatory patrons, if you will). But the local media aren't going to create them for you. You have to do that for yourself, one fan at a time. Now that may sound so futile as to be foolish, but consider this: each member of your state association, with minimal effort, can easily recruit one new member. Result: you double your membership practically overnight. Granted, some members are cantankerous, and would refuse to go along (a colleague of a famous nay-saying congressman once said that if he were to hear that his colleague had fallen in the river and drowned, he would begin looking for the body upstream), but some members would sign up more than one and so it would all even out.

6) Casual chessplayers are easy to find. They're everywhere. They share your love of chess. But somewhere they went wrong. While you were learning notation and having your emotions stimulated by the beauty and pathos in the vast library of recorded games, their chessplaying friend had moved away. When you were discovering the thrill of lightening chess, no one in their circle ever came across a chess clock. By the time you were abandoning the Ruy Lopez for the Sicilian, they had forgotten exactly when you can and cannot castle. These are not crimes against humanity. They're merely an expression of a tendency towards aberrant behavior which you can help to correct. The few minutes you spend explaining your state association, showing its publication and extolling its virtues, can result in many hours of pleasure for them and some fine moments of satisfaction for you. U.S. Chess will be healthier for you effort. So go out and find some of them. Bring them back to the fold.

## Crossville Scholastics

The Crossville Scholastics again attracted some of the best scholastic players together for an exciting weekend of chess. There were 268 players on 51 teams participating for more than 100 individual and team trophies.

Two players from Tennessee turned out scores of  $4\frac{1}{2}$  -  $\frac{1}{2}$  to earn co-champion honors. They were Bill Hall from Cumberland County High School and Oliver Tai from Cordova. The closely contested team competition was won by Auburndale School, with Pulaski County and Cumberland County each placing  $\frac{1}{2}$  point back in the final standings.

Tri-champions David Smith, Jim Johnson, and Chuck Ogden each scored  $4\frac{1}{2}$  -  $\frac{1}{2}$  to pace the High School Novice Section. The top team honors went to Auburndale School, first place; Red Bank, second place; and Pulaski County, third place.

In the Junior High Championship Section, Brad Skaggs from South Oldham scored a perfect 5-0 to win first place. Charlotte County Day School was the championship team winner with Murray Middle School from Kentucky placing second and Martin Junior High from Crossville taking third place.

Vickie Lambert from Pulaski County Middle School took top honors in the Junior High School Novice Section, and with the help of her teammates, the group won the top team prize. North Fulton High School from Atlanta, Georgia placed second, while Baylor School from Chattanooga took home the third place trophy.

Four players from the Elementary Championship Section achieved co-champion recognition. Cole Bass, T. Ryan Deering, Jason Cohen, and Harold Simmons each had an admirable performance with  $4 \cdot 1$  scores. The team champion was First Ward Elementary from Charlotte, North Carolina. Auburndale School placed second, and Critzer Elementary earned third place honors.

Brian Vaughan of Critzer Elementary dominated the Elementary Novice Section, while he and his team distanced the competition by placing  $5\frac{1}{2}$  points ahead of the closest team, Auburndale. Holy Trinity and Billingsville Elementary tied for third, while Homestead Elementary finished  $\frac{1}{2}$  point behind those two to capture fifth place.

The Primary Section boasted another player with a perfect 5 - 0 score . . . Michael Klein of Beverly Woods. The Holy Trinity School of Harlan, Kentucky was the champion in the team competition. Auburndale School took second, while Claremont Elementary placed a close third.



Knowing how to use your pieces effectively is one of the hardest lessons to learn. The Knight and Bishop mate is the most difficult to perform and requires patience and knowledge. If you know it and your opponent doesn't, then you will be far ahead of the game.


To start out, you must know that to mate with Knight and Bishop, you must mate the opposing King in the corner that is the same color as your Bishop. To get the King to the cornect corner, it is sometimes necessary to drive the King to the corner that is opposite color of your Bishop and then herd him to the opposite side of the board to the correct corner.

While doing this, you must be careful not to let the King escape and get to the center of the board or you will have to start all over again and you just may very well run out of moves before you have the chance to mate him!

Let's start with this position:



This game was chosen as **Best Game** of the tournament. The honor was given to Lentz; however, perusal of this game should show anyone that it was Drake who showed vision. Unfortunately White, executing a fundamentally sound sacrifice that embodies some brilliance, gets excited over spotting the lengthy combination and enters the complications without first considering his weakness. No matter, Joe Drake shows great promise in having reached a won position and spotted a combination of depth. Brian Lentz capitalizes on the error and executes Joe flawlessly and swiftly.
