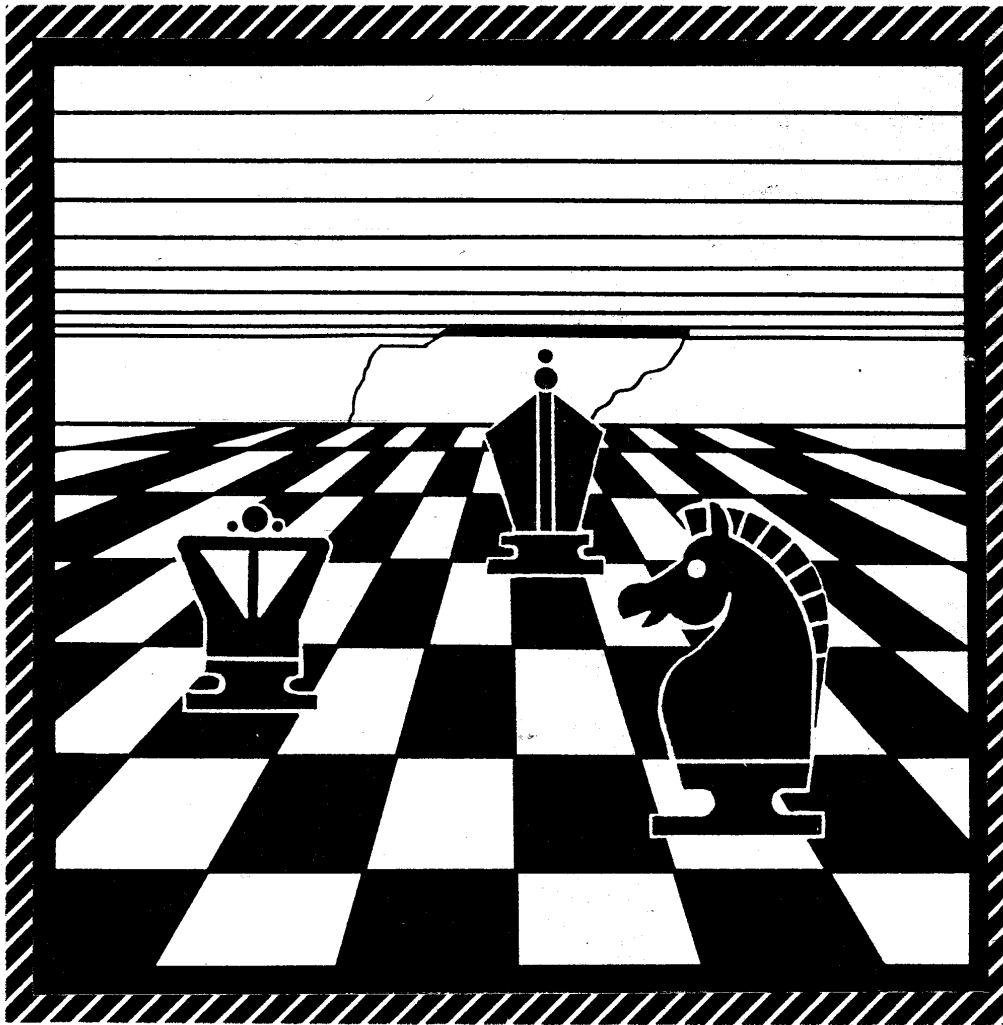

## THE PRESIDENT'S COLUMN

Greetings once again, my chess playing brethren. I would like to start this issue's column by congratulating USCF Postal Master (and recent O-T-B Master) Joe Jones on his spectacular victory in the state postal chess championship. I find it hard to think of anyone else more deserving of this title. I also think it a virtual impossibility to find a more sportsmanlike competitor in this state. Our hats are off to you, Joe. Now maybe you'll have the time to invest in sharing your knowledge by starting a scholastic program like you used to do.

And now, to my all-time favorite topic, MONEY! I am told by professional fundraisers that million dollar contributions, while wonderful and awesome to behold, do NOT make up a large portion of charitable donations. It's the nickels and dimes that make up the bulk of what we see on the toteboards of telethons. With that in mind, I appeal to the youngsters in scholastic chess clubs to help us build our scholastic and endowment funds. Small projects, easy to do, like paper and aluminum can recycling, can raise valuable funds for your clubs and our association's trust funds. The scholastic fund is rapidly approaching its first thousand. Help put us over the top. I envision a day when children can enter our state scholastic championships at no charge, when every school in the state has a thriving program, when every school has a paid, professional coach, and when one of these schools produces a new world champion, an AMERICAN world champion, a TENNESSEE WORLD CHAMPION. Help us plant the seed.

As always, I appeal to adults as well. The state endowment fund needs your help, too. Can't you envision a \$100,000 state championship? Can't you see us hosting tournaments comparable to Hastings, Wijk aan Zee, or Tilburg? How about part of the world championship cycle? Tennessee can become a haven for world-class master strength players. Unfortunately, that won't happen unless

we get off our duffs and get cracking. And don't count on Joe Q. Neighbor to do your part either! It is EVERY member's responsibility. Let's put all the pieces together and do something great. The only thing holding us back is the smallness of our minds.

As a final note, I wish to applaud the hard-working volunteers that put together the new scholastic formats. I realize that this is quite a departure from the past. Some people will undoubtedly oppose it. Some others will oppose change in ANY form. We based our model on what was done in Kentucky because we saw an explosion in the number of players (and members) that could only be explained by the change in format. How can more tournaments be bad? How can shifting to one-day formats, eliminating overnight expenses, hurt scholastic players? How can doing away with tied champions, simply because they can't be paired against each other be an injustice? Yet, I've heard rumblings that an individual in one region is so disenchanted that he plans to run conflicting tournaments in attempt to sabotage the state association championships. THAT shouldn't be too hard to do, since these things usually run on a shoestring budget anyway. Nonetheless, I find it inconceivable that anyone would ever consider such a thing when all I hear is "more tournaments, MORE TOURNAMENTS!", everywhere I go.

Let's remember that our association is a democratic organization, run by elected officials. If you aren't happy about what your board is doing, approach them with your grievances. If you get no satisfaction there, support new candidates, or better still, RUN FOR OFFICE YOURSELF!! For heaven's sake, when all is said and done, learn to live with majority rule. Our association cannot co-exist with anarchy.

**MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE  
BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE TENNESSEE CHESS ASSN.  
December 31, 1988**

A regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the Tennessee Chess Association was held at Fairfield Glade Resort, Crossville, Tennessee on Saturday, December 31, 1988, at 10:00 a.m.

Directors present were Bill Orgain, Harry Sabine, Mark Schindler, Rick Igou, Mark Ishee, Lee Edwards, Morris Lewis, and Chester Crowley. Directors absent were Curt Jones and Paul Linxwiler. Also present during the meeting were Mark Oshman and Ron Burnett.

President Orgain presided. The minutes of the Board of Directors meeting of September 4, 1988 were approved.

Officers' reports were given by Bill Orgain, Harry Sabine, Mark Schindler, Lee Edwards, Rick Igou, and Mark Ishee.

No bids had been received for the 1989 Tennessee Open. A committee of Rick Igou, Mark Ishee, and Chester Crowley was appointed to finalize all details concerning the event.

No bids had been received for the 1989 Tennessee Amateur Team Tournament. A committee consisting of Lee Edwards, Mark Schindler and Harry Sabine was appointed to consider any future bids received for the tournament. Bids were to be submitted by February 15th.

Mark Ishee reported on behalf of Curt Jones that a grant of \$250.00 had been received from the American Chess Foundation for the 1989 Tennessee Scholastics. It was agreed to allow an entry fee of \$8.00 for the Tennessee Junior Open for all students who pay the entry fee at the team regionals or finals.

The Hall of Fame Committee presented a draft of a proposal to establish a Tennessee Chess Hall of Fame. A copy of the draft is attached to the minutes of this meeting. It was agreed that a final proposal would be presented at the next Board meeting.

Bill Orgain reported that talks were proceeding to arrange a Tennessee - Kentucky match.

The next meeting of the Board of Directors was set for Friday, March 31, 1989 at 8:00 p.m. at the offices of Schindler Printing, Inc. in St. Bethlehem, Tennessee.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

## Tennessee Chess Hall of Fame

### ELIGIBILITY

Players, directors, organizers and promoters are all eligible for inclusion. Players shall be selected for induction based on whatever criteria the Hall of Fame Committee deems appropriate.

### HALL OF FAME COMMITTEE

Members of the Hall of Fame shall be chosen by a Hall of Fame Committee, which shall be chosen by the TCA Board of Directors.

Hall of Fame Committee shall be composed of 10 members. It is not necessary for the Hall of Fame Committee to be composed of TCA Board Members, although TCA Board Members are eligible to serve.

The Hall of Fame Committee shall elect a Chairman who shall be responsible for distributing and counting the ballots, as well as for reporting the results of the annual election to the TCA Board.

Hall of Fame Committee will hold an election every year for potential new Hall of Fame inductees.

Committee has full authority over all matters pertaining to the Hall of Fame and will not require final approval from the TCA Board for its decisions.

### INDUCTION

The TCA Board of Directors will submit a ballot for the Committee's consideration. No more than 5 names shall appear on the ballot.

It is not required that the Committee elect new inductees every year.

A 70 % majority vote (i.e. 7 votes out of 10) of the Committee shall be necessary to elect a new member to the Hall of Fame.

Each Committee member may vote for up to 3 persons per ballot. Members are not required to vote for any of the candidates on the ballot; i.e. 0, 1, 2 or 3 votes may be cast by each Committee member. Thus, it is theoretically possible to elect up to 4 new Hall of Fame inductees every year (4 x 7 = 28 out of 30 total votes cast).

Committee members may write in any candidate's name if the name for which they wish to vote does not appear on the ballot.

Each member may vote once per candidate. Multiple votes by a single Committee member for a single Candidate will count as one vote.

### CHARTER MEMBERS

The TCA Board of Directors shall authorize the induction of an unspecified number of Charter Members to the Hall of Fame by whatever means it deems appropriate.

If you are already a TCA member, the entry fee is a mere \$6.00 and all fees are returned in prize money. You get six games against three opponents. Score four or more points and you advance to the finals.

Your Postal Coordinator recently won a USCF thematic in the Schliemann Defense to the Ruy Lopez with a perfect 6-0 score. Does this mean that you'd better avoid that Schliemann like nerve gas the next time you face your Coordinator? No, your Coordinator is far from being a Schliemann specialist; he lucked out when all of his opponents, including the ones who were soundly thrashing him, decided to forfeit! It's nice to win \$20 book credits and it's not so bad when the one "biggie" who has you crushed decides he doesn't want to trifle with you anymore, but it is rather disconcerting when **ALL** of your opponents disappear from the face of the earth.

It's also disconcerting when your opponent in Los Angeles is slower than your opponent in Vladivostok. You can't help but get a sneaky suspicion that the Californian is "fudging" a bit on his dates. A prominent player once told me that the reason he didn't play in ICCF events was the rule requiring that repeat moves be sent by registered mail. However, I recently started sending repeats to persistently late American opponents by certified mail. This is not required, but it is more efficient than sending several postcards or hiring a private detective to stake out your opponent's house in L.A. He can't lie about the date he received your move either. If he's serious about continuing, he will be impressed by your "wake-up call"; if he doesn't respond, you've got proof enough for any postal director, or Judge Wapner, for that matter. ICCF rules also allow the use of computers which TCA and most domestic postal organizations do not. I hope to take up the subject of computers and cheating in postal chess in my next column.

Our featured postal game this time is, as promised, the battle between Bill Orgain and Joe Jones for the state championship. According to Joe, Black played an inferior opening, narrowly escaped defeat, and held on for some twenty moves. However, by move 34, Black was slightly better. Orgain had to win to tie for the championship, refused a draw offer, and lost after going for broke.

## **U-1600**

### **THE OPENING - Part 2**

In the last issue we looked at the opening and the term *DEVELOPMENT*. In this issue, we will go a step farther and go to the first basic rule of the opening which is:

1) Open with either a King or Queen Pawn.

There are several reasons for this rule and we will look at some of them. First, when advanced two squares, these pawns control two of the center squares on the board. Control of the center is very important because it allows faster development of your pieces. It also allows you to post your pieces to their best squares when you get ready to start your attack. If your opponent controls the center, then you will have to place your pieces away from the center where they will be less active on offense and will have a hard time getting into the game if you have to have them for defense.

Second, advancing the King or Queen Pawn opens a diagonal for one of your Bishops which allows for faster development. If you can develop your pieces before your opponent can develop his pieces, you can begin your attack before your opponent is ready and you will have an advantage that you may be able to turn into a win.

Third, opening with a King or Queen Pawn is the first step in learning the basic opening principles upon which the game of chess is based. Once you have mastered these principles, you will have an edge over your opponent and will know how to proceed if your opponent makes a move that is not consistent with these rules. You'll be able to take advantage of his or her lack of knowledge or deliberate disregard of opening rules by making moves that force your opponent to violate other rules of the opening, or further weaken his or her position in some way.

## WHEELER REPEATS AS NASHVILLE CHAMPION

National Master Jerry Wheeler, winner of the 1988 Nashville Chess Championship, successfully defended his crown in a five-round round-robin playoff held February 11-12, 1989. Wheeler was challenged by Alexander Zhislin and Morris Lewis, both finalists from previous years, and by first-time qualifiers RO Mitchell, Andrew Mongin, and Joseph Crump.

Each of the six finalists qualified from a preliminary section by finishing either first or second. This year's preliminaries were the largest ever, with 27 aspirants vying for only six qualifying spots. The prelims were a cooperative effort between the Fugitive Chess Club of Brentwood and the Nashville Chess Club. Directors for both the preliminaries and the finals were Peter Lahde and Mark Ishee.

The championship finals were hosted by Crockett Academy of Nashville, a special school for emotionally disturbed children. Special thanks go to Dr. Gary Yarnall, chess club director at Crockett Academy, who was instrumental in arranging the tournament site and who also contacted local newspapers to help publicize the event. Crockett Academy has an active chess club — many of the students showed strong interest in the chess tournament and enjoyed meeting the players between games.

### ROUND 1

Mongin — Lewis 1-0

Wheeler — Zhislin (adjourned)

Crump — Mitchell 0-1

Mitchell got off to a fast start by outplaying Crump from the black side of an English Opening — a few passive moves by Crump were all it took for Mitchell to seize the initiative. While trying to save a wayward piece, Crump succumbed to a direct kingside attack.

Meanwhile, Andrew Mongin's unusual opening variation gave Morris Lewis the chance for a big opening advantage with black in the Pirc/Modern Defense, but when Lewis strayed from the straight and narrow path he found himself with a dubious position and in time trouble as well. Both sides erred near the end of this exciting game, and finally Lewis lost on time with only two moves to go until time control.

Wheeler and Zhislin, the two top-rated players in the event, played a King's Indian Defense in which Wheeler applied steady pressure and maintained a space advantage throughout the middlegame. Ruthless technique yielded Wheeler a winning endgame advantage, but then a momentary slip near the time control put

the win in doubt. The game was adjourned in a simplified position where it was unclear if White's extra pawn would be of any use in breaking Black's defensive blockade.

Lewis continued to experience clock trouble in this round – after reaching a drawn position against Mitchell, he left a whole rook en prise while moving quickly just before time control.

Mongin and Wheeler played a tense Closed Sicilian, with approximate equality for most of the game. Wheeler's win of a pawn seemed meaningless in view of the opposite-colored bishop endgame position, but superior technique carried the day and earned Wheeler the full point.

Evidently the stresses of the previous games had taken their toll on both Lewis and Wheeler, for an Accelerated Sicilian Dragon was agreed drawn on Wheeler's offer after only 20 moves.

Once again Crump essayed the English Opening, and Mongin reacted with his favorite Dutch Defense formation. A tactical slugfest ensued, with both players going for a win in a complex position. Ultimately Crump erred and lost the exchange in the transition to the endgame, but Mongin returned the gift when he played a "helpmate," allowing mate in one!

Zhislin also played the English Opening, and Mitchell reacted with the same variation he had played in round one against Crump. In the late middlegame it seemed that Black had a winning shot, which he played. It turned out to be a trap which netted Zhislin an extra pawn and an attack in an opposite-color bishop position with heavy pieces remaining. But Mitchell managed to trade queens, after which the position was a simple draw despite the extra pawn.

Zhislin seemed to have the better position in the early middlegame after Lewis released pressure in the center, but in subsequent play Zhislin lost the exchange. The appearance of a passed pawn on the sixth rank was all Lewis needed to bag his first full point of the tournament.

Crump again tried the Modern Defense, but misplayed his center pawns and faced a large disadvantage in space. Wheeler carefully built up for the inevitable breakthrough, and then cashed in on the kingside with a pretty clearance motif.

Mitchell convincingly outplayed Mongin in a Dutch Defense featuring a queenless middlegame. Alert tactical play by Mitchell, coupled with infiltration into Mongin's underdeveloped position, paid off in pawns.

#### ROUND 5

Adjournment playoff: Wheeler – Zhislin 1/2-1/2

Because it is standing policy to finish all adjourned games before the final round of the tournament, Wheeler and Zhislin resumed their struggle from round

one after finishing their games from round four. Zhislin's blockade strategy proved effective, and the game was drawn. This set up a last-round showdown between tournament leader Mitchell (3 1/2 points) and defending champion Wheeler (3 points).

Mitchell – Wheeler 0-1

Mongin – Zhislin 0-1

Crump – Lewis 1-0

In the decisive last-round game, Mitchell bravely played for the win against Wheeler's King's Indian Defense and made large commitments with his center pawns. Wheeler's patient maneuvering soon won a pawn, and then Mitchell's game collapsed when Wheeler uncorked a tactical shot with a rampaging knight. Thus, 17-year-old Mitchell's first bid for the city championship fell half a point short, and Wheeler once again claimed the title.

Mongin sought to avoid the tournament cellar by surprising Zhislin with an unorthodox opening variation, but Zhislin reacted well and soon had the better game. Subsequent inaccuracies by Mongin gave Zhislin a large advantage, which he converted into a full point.

Crump and Lewis played a very tense game. It was obvious from the outset that neither player was interested in a draw. Crump's Reti Opening resulted in a bizarre middlegame position with which both players seemed to be unfamiliar. Agonizing complexities finally settled into the win of a piece for Crump, whereupon Lewis resigned.
