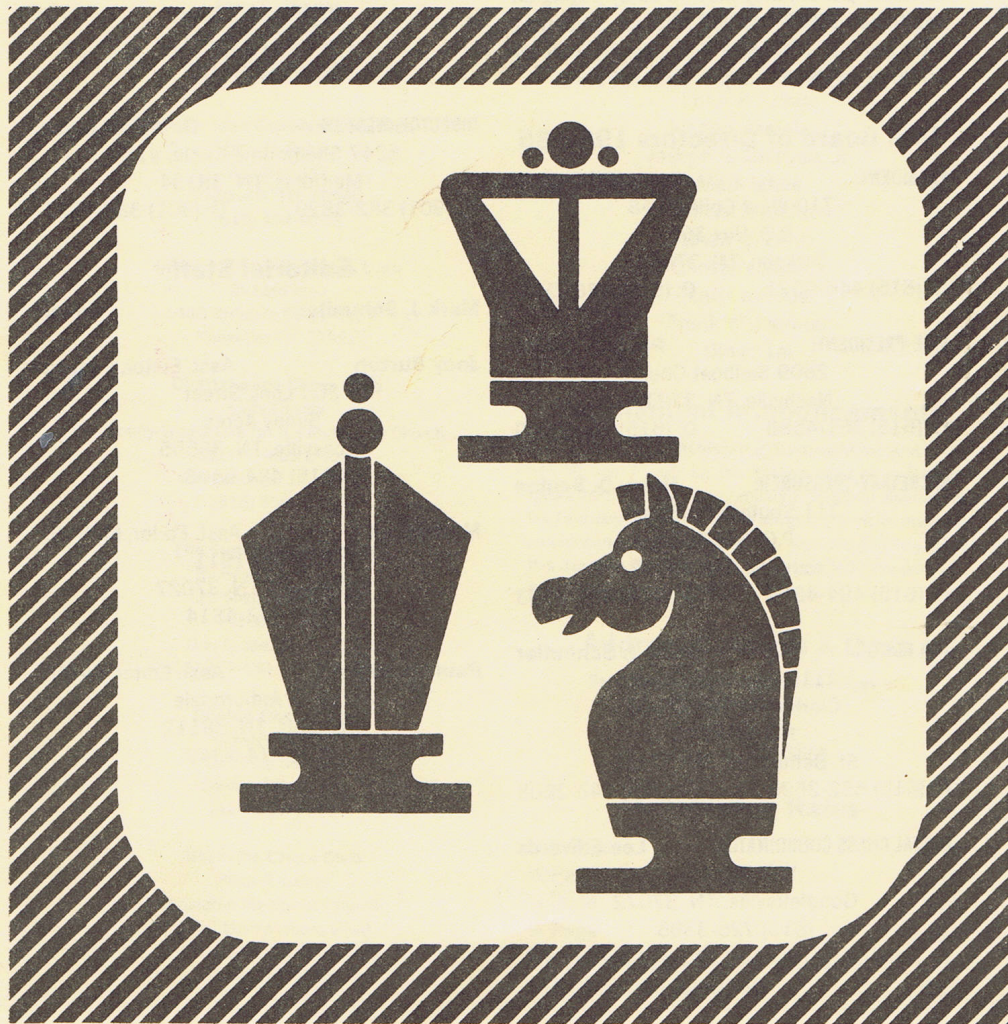

Greetings, fellow chess players. It's time to remind you that the slates have been wiped clean in the Tennessee Turkey Tour, a new year is beginning. Be sure to get out to your local tourneys and try to travel a little bit as well. Personally, I've always enjoyed the road trips. I'm sure that you will too!

Schools are opening up across the state, and scholastic chess tournaments begin to dot the landscape. Take some time out to help a youngster learn to play. For the more ambitious, we want you to start full-blown chess programs. We must remember that our future relies on our youth. For an organization such as ours, we have but two choices - - - grow or die. The choice is yours.

Here are a few hints. First, remember that scholastic memberships in the United States Chess Federation do not cost a penny anymore, so long as the student does not want to receive Chess Life. That has been a stumbling block in the past. Second, if you've had similar experiences to mine, you've become increasingly frustrated with school bureaucrats. You don't HAVE TO go through the schools to get to the kids! In my area, I am developing contacts through the Scouts. Local church youth groups are a good starting point as well. Please pass along your ideas for non-traditional approaches to youth.

If you are successful in getting your youth group together, there are two people that you need to contact. Vince McCambridge is the USCF Technical Director and can provide you with invaluable supplies. Curt Jones is our State Scholastic Coordinator and can put your group in touch with other groups.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank my past Board of Directors for their courage in implementing an austerity program during my first term of office. Thanks to their efforts, we are once again in the black and can begin moving ahead. You will soon begin receiving some of the fruits of our labors when the next issue of our magazine comes out. We will be returning to a Bi-Monthly format. Editorial staff BEWARE - - - your deadlines have just been moved up a month!

The most important decision made by your new Board of Directors was to do away with the rotation system for the Tennessee Open. Next year's bid is open to ANY affiliate across the state. The time is NOW to begin working on your bid, as it will take a good one to win it! I'm certain that this competition between affiliates will create the best Tennessee Open EVER, and no one will be left out of the picture. We must build our state championship up to a point of respectability again. Most of our bordering states have their state championships on Labor Day weekend as well. A regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the Tennessee Chess Association was held at the Auburndale School on Sunday, September 6, 1987 at 9:00 a.m.

Directors present were Bill Orgain, Peter Lahde, Harry Sabine, Mark Schindler, Rick Igou, Curt Jones, Chester Crowley, Ron Burnett, and Dale Flickinger. The Director absent was Lee Edwards. Also present was Clifford Anderson.

President Orgain presided. The minutes of the Board of Directors meeting held on June 14, 1987 were approved.

Officer reports were given by Bill Orgain, Harry Sabine, Mark Schindler, Rick Igou, and Curt Jones.

The budget for 1987-88 was approved with a copy attached to the minutes of the meeting.

The Tennessee Chess News was discussed. It was the consensus of the Board that the next issue be a quarterly issue and then switch to a bi-monthly publication if the Editor feels it can be done within the budget.

It was agreed to notify the USCF to hold the Tennessee SASP funds pending further requests by the Board.

It was voted to hold a 1987-88 Turkey Tour with the same format and rules as for 1986-87.

The budget for the 1988 Tennessee Scholastics was approved and a copy ordered attached to the minutes of this meeting.

It was also approved to combine the Championship and Novice Junior High sections for the 1988 Tennessee Scholastics.

The rotation of the Tennessee Open was discussed. Bill Orgain made a motion to allow open bidding from any area of the state for the Tennessee Open in future years. Peter Lahde proposed a substitute motion that the Tennessee Open always be held in Middle Tennessee in the future. The substitute motion failed by a vote of 2-7 and the Orgain motion was approved by a vote of 5-4. It was noted by Mark Schindler that there was a danger that a group with sufficient money could bid for the tournament every year in the same location.

It was noted that the 1988 United States Junior High Tournament would be held on May 6-7, 1988 in Memphis, sponsored by Auburndale School.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:05 p.m.

1987-88 TENNESSEE TURKEY TOUR

The Tennessee Turkey Tour, (hereafter referred to as TTT), is a year-long contest to help promote the current high standards of Tennessee chess participation and competition. The 5th Annual TTT will span the period 9/8/87 through the 1988 Tennessee Open.

For a tournament to qualify as a TTT event, it must meet the following requirements:

- 1) Be USCF rated
- 2) Require TCA dues for TN residents (no other dues may be required except USCF dues).
- 3) Be an open weekend tournament in Tennessee of at least three rounds in length.
- 4) Be cleared through the TN Tournament Coordinator and advertised in the TCN tournament calendar.
- 5) A copy of the final wall chart and appropriate TTT fees must be submitted to the Tournament Coordinator within 2 weeks of the date of the tournament.

A. PRIZE FUND:

The prize fund will be formed from tournament round fees (USCF Grand Prix events - \$5/rd.; all other tournaments - \$3/rd.) and other donations. Prizes will be awarded to the top players of each class by the following percentages of the prize fund:

MASTER/EXPERT, Class A	1st - 10%
	2nd - 5%
	3rd - 3%
Class B,C,D,E	1st - 8%
	2nd - 5%
	3rd - 3%

B. CONDITIONS OF AWARDED PRIZES:

- 1) The final class standing of a player will be determined by the September 1988 USCF rating supplement.
- 2) TTT points accumulate for a player who moves up to a higher rating class, but the player remains eligible for prizes in the lower class based upon the points earned while in that class. If a player moves to a lower class, points earned in the higher class are not counted for the lower class standing, and points earned in the lower class will not be carried forward if the player moves again into a higher class.

- 3) A player may win only one prize and will be awarded the greater prize for which he or she is eligible.
- 4) Players whose USCF class designation shows a former rating 101 or more points over a prize class will not be eligible for that class prize but will be eligible for the prizes in the next higher class. Only players with permanent ratings are eligible for prizes. However, players will accumulate points during the time that their rating is provisional and those points will be credited to them in their first permanent rating class.
- 5) Players must be TCA members to accumulate and collect TTT points.
- 6) The Tournament Coordinator is responsible for compiling the class standings and awarding prizes.

C. EARNING TTT POINTS:

TCA members may earn TTT points for tournament participation and performance as follows:

- 1) Each player participating in a Tennessee-USCF Grand Prix TTT event will earn 20 TTT points; players participating in the Tennessee Open will earn 30 TTT points; and players participating in all other TTT events will earn 10 TTT points. Players must complete at least ½ of the scheduled rounds in a tournament to earn these points.
- 2) Players will be awarded additional TTT points for a positive performance result in any TTT event by the following formula: Wins minus losses times number of rounds equals performance points. Players must complete the tournament to earn any performance points. Unplayed games except for Byes or forfeit wins will be counted as losses for this calculation.

Cumberland County Fall Open I and II

The Cumberland County Fall Open I produced co-champions with Bill Melvin and Brian Smith both scoring 3½ points to split the top prize. Curtis Graham and Brian Lentz tied for the Class A prize. The Class B prize was split three ways as Allen Chandler, Michael McKinley, and Reuben Morris all scored 2 points.

James Ellis, rated 1516 going into the tournament, scored an impressive 3 points to take the Class C prize. Even MORE amazing is the fact that he scored the 3 points by drawing two Experts, and defeating two Class A players!

The Amateur Section also had co-champions with Wayne Tolbert and Janice Peddieson drawing in the fourth round to tie for First place. Mike Stokes scored 3 points to win the Unrated prize.

The Cumberland County Fall Open II used a new sixty minute sudden death time control. This faster time control produced some exciting chess, while it also allows those participants who traveled to the tournament an earlier departure than with the previously used time control.

Alan Lipkin must have enjoyed the new time control, for he scored 3½ points to tie for First place with Neal Harris. Lipkin, a Class B player, had an incredible day, defeating the top Class A player and an Expert. Jeffrey Kidd and James Johnson tied for the Expert prize. Class A was won by Michael Gee with 3 points. Geoffrey Caveney won the Class C prize. Michael Lipkin also collected some upsets as he scored 2½ points to claim the Class D prize. Adam Caveney scored 1½ points to win the Unrated prize.
