



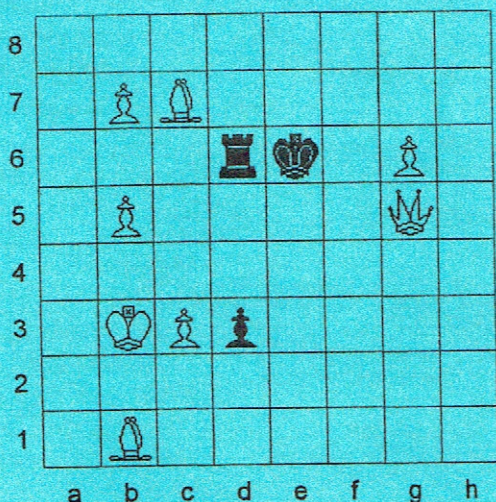

THE NORTH TENNESSEE WINTER OPEN

The Tennessee Chess Association sponsored the Fourth annual North Tennessee Winter Open at the Riverview Inn in Clarksville Tennessee on Saturday, January 18, and Sunday, January 19, 2003. One Hundred and Twenty Five players from seven states participated.

The Kings section fielded fifteen players. Four were Masters and one was a Life-Master. The Queens section had more players than ever before, with eleven players competing. Twenty-Three youth and scholastic players took advantage of the junior entry fee and played for trophy only. One even won his section. (should have gone for the money) Despite the snowy conditions and the frigid temperatures every one that participated enjoyed the competition and the tournament.

Thirteen trophies and twenty-seven cash prizes, totaling \$4,000, were awarded. The winners are listed below:

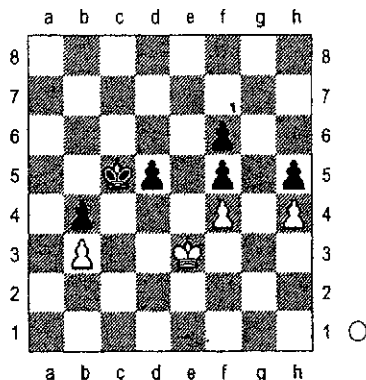

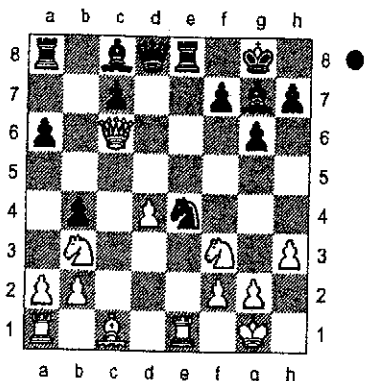

Bill Hall Wins 31st Annual Cumberland County Chess Championship

Former champion Bill Hall is once again the Cumberland County Chess Champion. Mr. Hall claimed the title by winning all five of his matches. He was the only player in the field of over fifty players to complete the tournament with a perfect score of 5 wins and no losses.

This year's tournament, which was sponsored by the Cumberland County Bank, was held on Saturday, December 7, at South Cumberland Elementary School. Fifty-four chess players, ranging in age from 7 to 70, competed in the tournament.

Mr. Hall also won the title in 1988, 1999, and 2000. He did not play in the 2001 tournament. He recently completed classes at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology and is currently teaching mathematics at Cumberland County High School.

Jeremy Carter came out of "retirement" to take second place with a score of 4.5-0.5. Jeremy played on Cumberland County High School's State Championship teams in the late 1990's. Third place went (again!) to Harry Sabine, a local attorney. Mr. Sabine is also the State Scholastic Chess Coordinator. J.T. Simpson, an eighth grade student at Pine View Elementary School, finished fourth. Another eighth grade student, Eric Donnan, of Crab Orchard Elementary School, took fifth place. Eric's father, Alex Donnan, was the top unrated player. Logan Blakenship, an eighth grade student at Pleasant Hill Elementary School, finished second among unrated players.

Class prizes were also awarded at the tournament. Michael Howard, a sixth-grader at Pine View, took first place in Class F. Jason Keeton, another eighth grade student at Pleasant Hill, finished first in Class G.

The TCA Guarantee Committee will review all proposed tournaments.

TCA Terms and Conditions

The Tennessee Chess Assoc will guarantee against any loss tournaments held in the State of Tennessee upon the following terms and conditions: The tournament organizer must agree:

- (1) To pay the TCA one third (1/3) of any profit made by the tournament.
- (2) To require and collect TCA membership of all Tennessee residents playing in the tournament.
- (3) To guarantee all prizes offered by the tournament (no based-on prizes).
- (4) To have the format and budget for the tournament approved by the TCA Guarantee committee.

In return, the TCA agrees to indemnify the organizer against any loss sustained by the tournament. The TCA will not advance funds for the tournament but will only reimburse the organizer for any loss after the tournament is over and a complete financial statement has been submitted by the tournament organizer to the TCA Guarantee committee.

The TCA explicitly reserves the right to limit our exposure on a tournament by tournament basis as part of the approval process.

Any organizer that would like to take advantage of this opportunity should submit five (5) copies of the proposed tournament plans, format, and budget to the TCA Guarantee Committee. Please mail proposals to:
