Format	5 Round Swiss Pairing System. Time Control: Game in 30 minutes each with a 5-second delay. All players complete five rounds, win, lose, or draw. Please let a tournament director if your player will be missing a round. Players who are late may receive a half-point bye in round 1-4 if requested by Rd. 2
