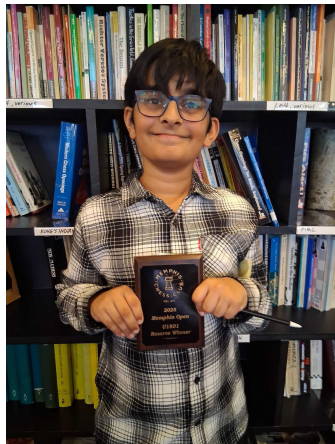
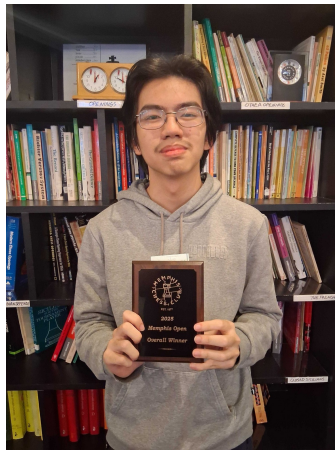
Championship, and Ghanishth came out on top with 2/2, so Ghanishth will be invited to the Memphis City Championship!

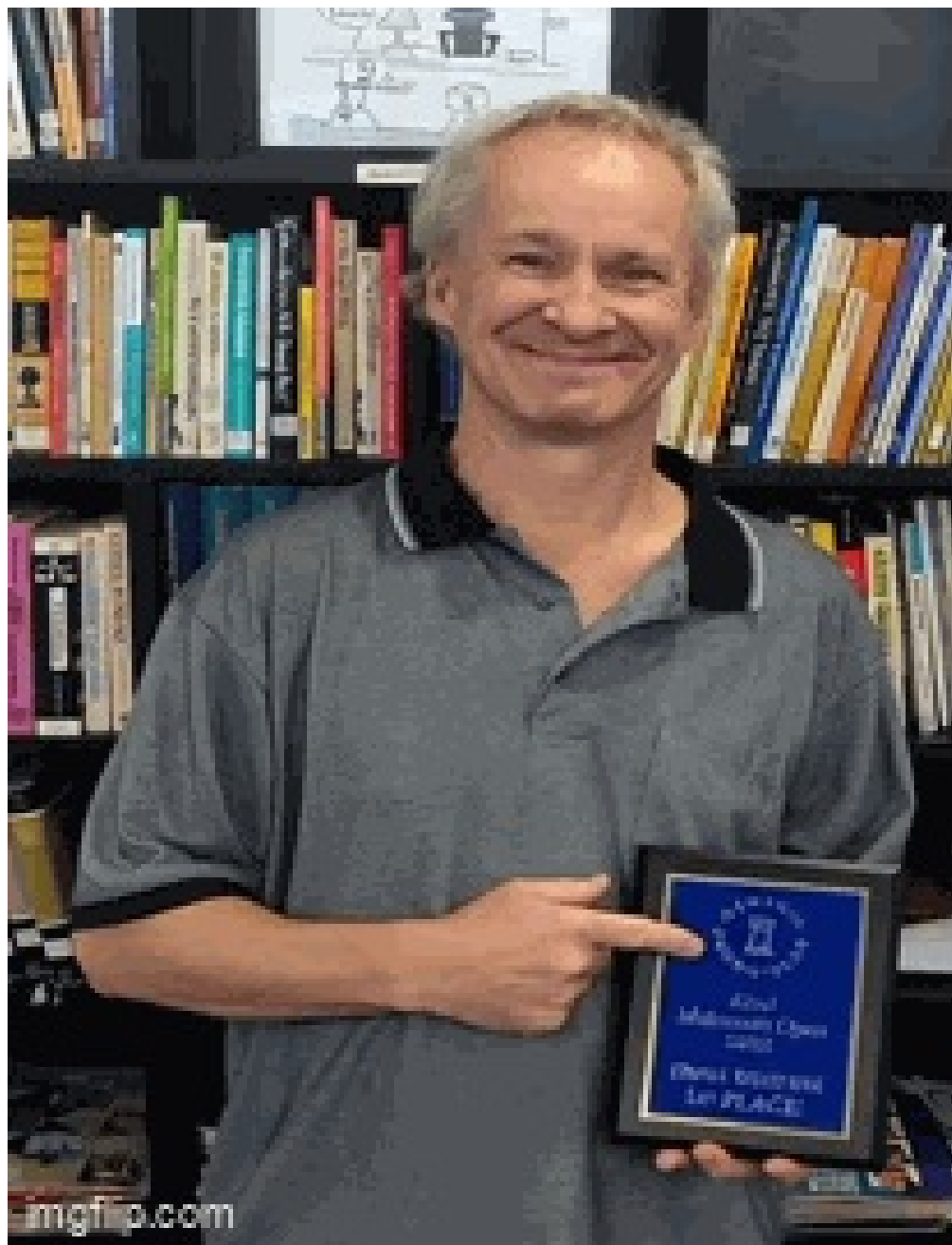

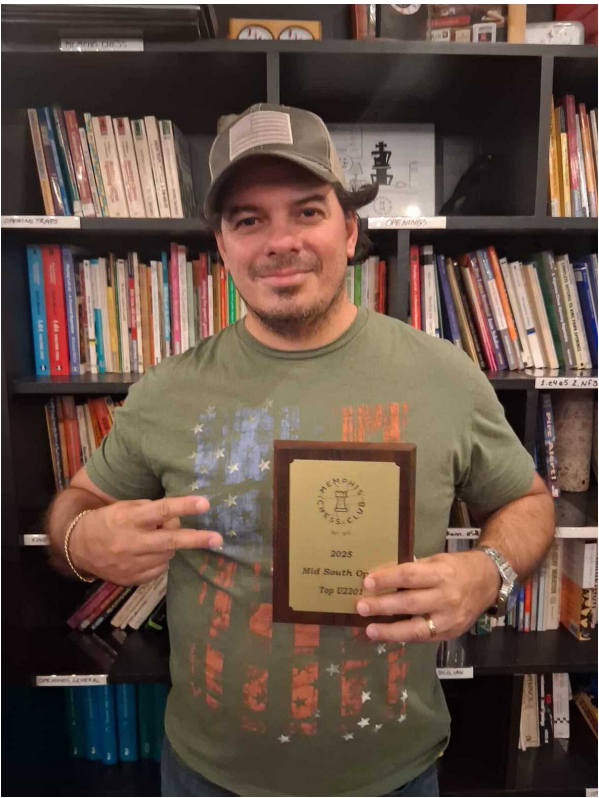

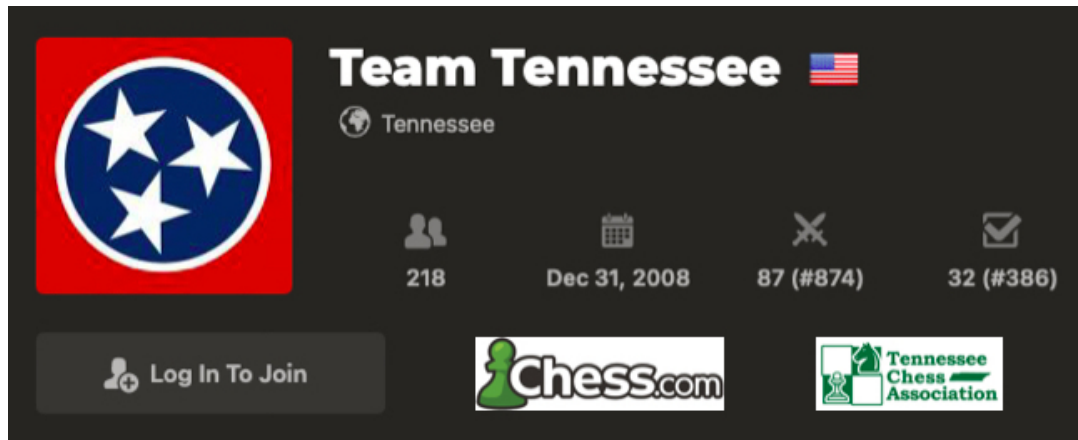
